

Literacy

In writing, we will be trying hard to blend and segment simple words to write labels, captions and sentences.

Our vocabulary will be extended through looking at different stories in class such 'We are going on a bear hunt' and 'Stick Man'.

The children will also be focussing on spelling sight words taught each week in phonics.

Communication and Language

The children are continually encouraged to use new vocabulary surrounding our topic when learning through play. During floor book activities, they will be using talk to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas and events.

Technology

We will be introducing simple ICT programs including ActivInspire. The children will be using directional language to send a programmable toy around a floor map. The children use digital cameras to capture work they are proud of e.g. a construction model.

Reading

The children will be continuing to decode simple words to read. Each week in phonics, the children will be introduced to new sounds and sight words. The reading zoo strategies that we will focus on this term are EAGLE EYE to look for clues in the pictures and STRETCHY SNAKE to remind us to sound out words.

Expressive Art and Design

The children will continue with carrying out music sessions in class. We will be constructing models with a purpose in mind using a variety of resources. The children will be introduced to new tools and techniques when painting and model making.

Maths

In maths we will be continuing to build our 'number sense' of numbers up to 5. This will involve, number recognition, finding one more and one less, practising our counting skills and simple addition and subtraction.

We will be using mathematical language to describe 2D and 3D shapes and looking for them in the environment.

We are working hard on our number formation through physical activities such as Jedi writing.

Physical Development

In PE on a Tuesday and Friday, the children will continue to work on how they can move in different ways. We will also be carrying out gross motor exercises to strengthen our muscles. In addition, the children will be participating in our weekly 'Physical Friday' activities
