We would like to offer the opportunity for your child to take part in the cross country race at Windmill Hill Primary School. Children will run as individuals around the school grounds against children from other Sheffield schools. The first race will begin at approximately 3:50pm with the running order of Year 3/4 girls, Year 3/4 boys, then Year 5/6 girls and finally Year 5/6 boys.

We are asking parents to transport their children to the venue and you can then stay and watch your child in the race. As soon as their race is finished, parents are welcome to take their child home or they can stay to support our school in the other races. Alternatively, if you are unable to stay, your child will be supervised at the event by members of Ecclesfield Primary staff and will **need collecting at 5:15pm**.

Children will need to wear their PE kit and suitable running shoes and will be provided with a t-shirt for the race. They may also wish to bring a water bottle and snack.

As there are limited spaces available for each year group, places will be drawn out of a hat if we have more replies than spaces. We will let you know as soon as possible if your child has a place or not.

In light of the pandemic, we have ensured a robust risk assessment is in place and have made plans as appropriate. **If your child develops symptoms during the event we would have to call upon you to collect your from Ecclesfield School.** Please do not send your child to school on the day if they are showing signs of the recognised symptoms of COVID 19.
