Jubilee Celebrations

Dear Parents and Carers

During the week commencing Monday 23rd May, we have organised a number of exciting activities to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee and are looking forward to welcoming families onto the school premises on the **afternoon of Thursday 26th May** to participate in our Jubilee Street Party to end the half term (weather dependant). Please see below for all of the information regarding the activities and events that will be taking place during this week.

Jubilee Bake-Off

We are inviting all pupils to enter our Jubilee Bake-Off Competition by making a Jubilee themed cake. It could be decorated using the union jack colours, or with sweets to look like jewels, or using any other Jubilee theme you can think of! The grander the better!



If your child wishes to participate, they should bring their competition entry into their classrooms on the morning of **Monday 23rd May**. A special guest will be given the important job of judging the entries later that day and the winners will be announced at our Jubilee Street Party on Thursday 26th May.

The entries will then be displayed in the large hall for parents and carers to view from **2.45pm on Monday 23rd May**. The cakes can then be taken home on Tuesday to be eaten!

Jubilee School Menu

On Thursday 26th May there will be a special school dinner menu:-

Blue - Chicken Burger, Chips, Peas and Sweetcorn
Red - Cheese and Tomato Pizza, Chips, Peas and Sweetcorn
Lemon Drizzle Cake (Fresh Fruit and Yoghurt also available)
Jacket potato and sandwich options will be available as normal

If your child would like one of the above school meal options, they simply need to order it with the teacher at morning registration as normal.



Jubilee Street Party

We are very excited to be inviting parents and carers onto the school grounds on the afternoon of **Thursday 26th May** and have many activities planned.

Arrival (1.30pm - 1.45pm)

Parents and carers to arrive at school, via the Well Lane entrance only. Further information giving directions for each adult to locate their child's street party area will be emailed out nearer to the date. Everyone is invited to wear red, white and blue to join in with the Jubilee theme.

Non-School Uniform

All children are invited to dress in red, white and blue colours for the day. Crowns will also be welcomed!



National Anthem and Street Party Food and Drink (1.45pm onwards)

Pupils, staff, parents and carers will all be singing the National Anthem to start the event, followed by party food and drinks!



We would kindly request that each child brings their own small picnic into class on the morning of Thursday 26th May to be eaten in the afternoon.

Refreshments will be on sale (such as hot dogs and cold drinks) for parents and carers to purchase so that they may also eat and drink too if they wish!

Field Events (2.15pm - 2.45pm)

After the children have eaten their street party food, there will be time for each class and their parents/carers to take part in games, share books and enjoy the festivities together in their designated area on the school field.

Singing Performance and Bake-Off Winner Announcement. (2.45pm)

The whole school will be performing a Jubilee-themed song for all of the parents and carers. The winners of the Jubilee Bake-Off will be announced and prizes given out. After this, the children will return to their classrooms to collect their belongings before leaving school at the normal time, from their usual exits.



Jubilee Stalls (1.45pm – 3.30pm)

Throughout the afternoon, school staff will be manning a number of stalls for you to visit during and after the Street Party. The stalls will close at **3.30pm**.

The list of stalls is still being finalised but we will aim to include the following:-

- Book stall (selling second hand children's books)
- Refreshment stall
- Guess the number of sweets in the jar stall
- Cake and bun stall
- Tombola
- Raffle stall
- Soak the Teacher stall (we are expecting this stall to be very popular!)

Donations

We would greatly appreciate any donations of the following items and can be brought to the school office at any time prior to Thursday 26th May.

- Individually wrapped buns and cakes.
- Children's books
- Tombola prizes such as toiletry sets, bottles of wine, bric-a-brac items, cuddly toys
