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### Remote Learning to Support Pupils Self-isolating

Dear Parents and Carers,

Where individual pupils need to self-isolate due to COVID-19 and are well enough to learn, we will continue to provide high quality remote education. Ecclesfield Primary has spent some considerable time developing a well-planned and well-designed curriculum. Therefore, if pupils are unable to attend school due to self-isolation and are well enough to continue with their learning, we will aim to teach the same curriculum remotely as we do in school wherever possible and appropriate.

FS pupils will access their learning via Class Dojo and Tapestry. Staff will upload learning activities to Class Dojo and parents are to upload any photos, videos or comments of the children's learning via Tapestry.

Y1-Y6 pupils will be able to access the Google Classroom for their year group and access the work that their teachers will have uploaded onto this platform. If you need a reminder of your child's username and password, please contact your child's class teacher.

It is incredibly important that all children keep up to date with their learning, especially if they are unable to come to school but are well enough to work at home.

We are also aware that continuing to have a healthy body and mind whilst unable to come into school is incredibly important. In school children are encouraged to take part in at least 30 minutes of activity each day and then 30 minutes at home as well.

Please find below some suggested resources to support your child's physical and mental wellbeing during their time at home. Whilst isolating, we would love to see any pictures of ways your child has stayed engaged and active and welcome these to be shared on their Class Dojo pages.
