Dear Parents and Carers,

Your child is invited to represent our school at the forthcoming Y4 Hotshots Basketball Festival at Ecclesfield School on Tuesday 9th November 2021. The children will be part of a squad and will be rotated/substituted throughout the festival so will all get plenty of court time.



We will be travelling to Ecclesfield School on a minibus that will leave Ecclesfield Primary at **3:20pm** for a **3:40pm** start. At the event, the children will be supervised by at least two members of Ecclesfield Primary Staff. Unfortunately, parents and carers will be unable to access the venue due to limited numbers being able to be inside the building, as is the policy at Ecclesfield School. **Children will need to be collected, by a parent or carer, from the car park at Ecclesfield School at 5:40pm.** There is no cost for travel to the venue. Children will just need to take a water bottle and snack with them for the evening.

As with all events delivered by Arches we have a limited number of places. We have been allocated 5 places for boys and 5 places for girls across Y4. If you are happy for your child to take part and are able to collect them after the competition, please fill in the £0.00 offer entitled "Y4 Basketball" on sQuid by Thursday 21st October. After this date you, names will be randomly selected and we will let you know if your child has been chosen as soon as possible.

Leading up to the event, if your child is chosen, we will run some practise sessions during lunchtimes to introduce them to the rules and some tactics.

In light of the pandemic, we have ensured a robust risk assessment is in place and have made plans as appropriate.



If your child develops symptoms during the event we would have to call upon you to collect your from Ecclesfield School. Please do not send your child to school on the day if they are showing signs of the recognised symptoms.
