Thank you to the families who responded to our parent survey in December 2022; we value your feedback and will endeavour to take your views on board. This letter explains the feedback from the survey and what we, as a school are doing as a result of your replies.

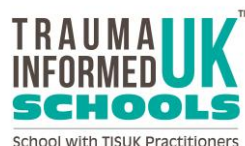
#### **READING**

We are pleased to hear that **over 95%** of parents/carers feel confident in supporting their child to read at home. For those of you who would like further support, we are planning to offer a reading workshop over the next two terms alongside reading newsletters which will offer up to date recommendations of books, recommendations of texts from teachers, an overview of what we're reading in class, a link to our school Virtual Library and ways you can help further your child's love of reading at home.

From your feedback, we have amended reading mornings to either Tuesdays or Fridays, to enable a greater number of adults to attend. We will continue to review the days and times of reading morning each term.

#### **HOMELEARNING**

**86%** of parents/carers reported that the amount of home learning given by school is just right. There was a split response in the preference between online and paper-based learning. Over the next term, we would like to gather a working party, including parents, staff and pupils to discuss ways to move forward with home learning and how school can best support homelearning. We would value parental contribution with this working party. If this is something that you'd like to be part of please speak to the office staff. In the Spring term, we have added a homework club to our menu of after school clubs to provide a quiet and calm space with members of staff to support pupils with their home learning. ## AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

65% of parents/carers reported that there are a good range of afterschool activities and that they are of a good quality.

A large proportion of the parents who responded, expressed an interest in a wider variety of activities to be offered afterschool. Whilst planning our afterschool club programme over the next two terms, we will take into account your suggestions and also those of our pupils.
