Dear Parents and Carers,

During the first half term of year 4, the unit of science learning will focus on teeth, digestion and how different animals, including humans, obtain their food; they will then understand how all these factors contribute to the classification of animals alongside the habitats that they are adapted to live in. To supplement our lessons in school, Yorkshire Wildlife Park offer a 'hands-on' educational opportunity with a range of living animals to help learn about the adaptations that animals undergo in relation to their nutritional habits. We have organised for both Year 4 classes to visit Yorkshire Wildlife Park on **Friday 6th October 2023**.

During the day, the children will have the opportunity to see the huge range of animals living within the park. They will also attend two workshops related to digestion and classification.

The cost of this visit is **£18.90**. This includes transport (£8.81) and the entrance/workshop fees (£10.09). Please ensure this contribution is paid by 11.59pm on Tuesday 5th September 2023 via **sQuid**. If you have any concerns with regards the payment, please let us know so that we can discuss this further with possible solutions.

Whilst we ask for voluntary contributions for educational visits, it is because there is a genuine need for the contribution to make the visit viable. The school is very grateful for all the support that you give.

Unfortunately, the visit will have to be cancelled if there are insufficient contributions. The full cost of the trip does need to be paid before the deadline of 11.59pm on Tuesday 5th September to ensure that the visit remains viable.



Children will need to come to school wearing their school uniform and will need to bring a drink and a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles). Depending on the weather, please ensure your child has a coat and suitable footwear. If you would like to order a packed lunch from school, please order this via sQuid and ensure the school meal fee is paid for in advance of the visit date.

We will be leaving school at **8.30am** so children should arrive at the **earlier time of 8.15am on the KS2 yard**. We aim to **arrive back at school at 4.00pm** in order to maximise the opportunity to visit all animals in the park. Children will need to be collected from **the main entrance (office) via Well Lane**. If we are delayed, we will contact parents via text to inform you of any changes.
