myON Reading Library Y2-Y6 Children

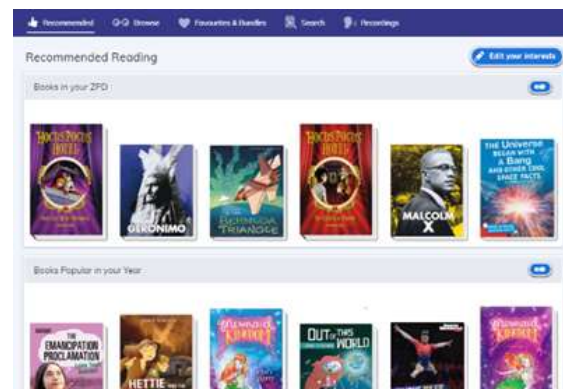
Dear Parents and Carers,

myON is an engaging way to access fiction and non-fiction books at home, on holiday or wherever you may be. You can access it by following the link below or typing into a web browser:

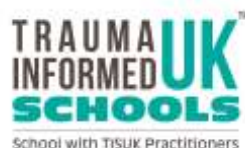
Your child logs into the system in exactly the same way they log into STAR assessments at school. This is something all children Y2-Y6 have done in school and it will also be shown to them again by their teachers in class.



This resource works like an online library. Once you are logged in, you will be able to search for exciting new reads in a number of ways:

- Books recommended for your child's reading age
- Books within an area of interest
- Books that are popular amongst other children in your child's year group

Simply select a book that interests you and get reading!



The books you select are colourful and entertaining. You can even choose a narrator to read the books to your child, if you prefer. As well as tailoring books to your child, the resource



also helps you keep a track of what you have been reading. Your child can earn points for the reading they complete, keep track of their total reading minutes and check in on weekly progress.

Please help your child to get used to this new resource – you will literally have thousands of texts at your fingertips. Please speak to your child’s teacher if you have any issues logging into the website.
