- discuss any behaviour or attendance issues
- where relevant, the discussion will include a shared joint approach towards addressing any concerns.

To book an appointment, you will need to use the Parents Evening Manager on ParentMail. This allows you to book your parents' evening appointment from your smartphone, tablet or computer as soon as the booking system becomes 'live' which will be **6.00pm tonight, Tuesday 7th November.**

Please do not delay if anything is worrying you, we all need to work together to resolve any issues.
