We would like to ask any spectators, adults and younger siblings, to remain behind the barrier if watching the competitive events. This will ensure that children are not disturbed whilst running on the track.

As the sports day is part of the curriculum, there is an expectation that all pupils will participate in all the events. Hopefully, the weather will be kind to us so we must ask parents to ensure that their child has adequate sun protection; please make sure



any sun cream is applied before school. Please ensure your child has a water bottle for the day, hat and full PE kit, including white t-shirt, shorts/jogging bottoms and suitable trainers. Earrings and jewellery must be removed and long hair tied back.

Entrance to School

All school gates will be open as usual at the start of the day.

All gates, except the Montenev gate, will be locked at 8.50am. The Montenev gate will be locked at 9.20am. Please note that there will be no access to this event via the Well Lane entrance after 8.50am.

The Montenev gate will re-open when the event has finished at 11.30am.

Parents and carers will not be able to gain access to the school from 9:20am until 11:30am. If you need to leave the school premises during this time or need further assistance, a marshal wearing a luminous vest will be able to assist.
