The School Age Immunisation Team will be visiting schools from September 2026 to give the **Seasonal Flu Vaccine** to children. **A single dose of the flu nasal spray will mean your child is less likely to become ill if they come into contact with the flu virus.**

	Flu Vaccination at Ecclesfield Primary School For: - all children aged 2 or 3 years on 31 August 2026 - primary school and secondary school-aged children (from reception to year 11) - individuals 17 years and over attending a special education needs (SEN) school may also be vaccinated alongside their peers.

	We need your consent to give your child the vaccine. When filling in the consent form, you will have 3 options:
	1. Nasal spray- This is the most effective way to protect your child from flu. (Please note: it contains pork gelatine.)
	2. Injectable flu vaccine - This version does not contain pork gelatine.
