- 10:35 – 11:40 – Individual track events Y5 and Y6 (lower field)

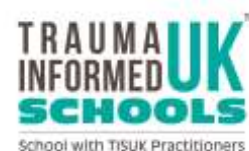
[Key Stage One](#) session times are as follows:

- 12:45 – 1:40 – Team events FS (top field)
- 12:45 – 1:40 – Individual track events Y1 and Y2 (lower field)
- 1:40 – 1:50 – Drinks Break
- 1:50 – 2:45 – Team events Y1 and Y2 (top field)
- 1:50 – 2:45 – Individual track events FS (lower field)



We would like to ask any spectators, adults and younger siblings to remain behind the barrier when watching the competitive events. This will ensure that children are not disturbed whilst running on the track.

As Sports Day is part of the curriculum, we encourage all children to join in with all of the events. Hopefully, the weather will be kind to us so we must ask parents/carers to ensure that their child has adequate sun protection, sun cream, a water bottle and a hat. Earrings and jewellery must be removed and long hair tied back.



The Teams

The whole school will be split into four teams – Blue team, Red team, Green team and Yellow team. The children are encouraged to come in PE clothes that represent their team colour and will win points for their team during the track and field events. All children from FS – Y6, as well as the staff, will be part of a team, and the leader board will be updated throughout the day.

Next week, the children will be told which team they are in by their class teacher.

Entrance to School on the Day - Key Stage Two (Morning events)

- All school gates will be open as usual at the start of the day.
- All gates, except the Montenev gate, will be locked at 8.45am. The Montenev gate will be locked at 9.20am.
- Please note that there will be no access to this event via the Well Lane entrance after 8.45am.
- The Montenev gate will re-open when the event has finished at 11.40am for parents and carers to exit.

Entrance to School on the Day - Key Stage One (Afternoon events)

- To ensure the safety of the children, entry onto the school premises for the afternoon session will be via the Montenev Gate only.
- Please note that there will be no access to the afternoon event via the Well Lane entrance.
- The Montenev gate will open at 12:40pm
- The Montenev gate will be locked between 1.00pm and 2:45pm

Parents and carers will not be able to gain full access to the school building during the day. If you need to leave the school premises during this time or need further assistance, a staff member wearing a high-vis vest will be able to assist you. Please note that the only available adult toilets will be via the Key Stage Two green door.
