Dear Parents and Carers,

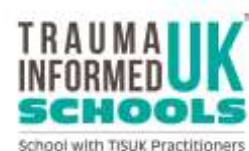
We are excited to announce that on **Tuesday 14th April**, Ecclesfield Primary School will be holding a special **Writing Themed Day** for all pupils.
