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Beat The Street is coming to Sheffield June 16th - July 28th

From Wednesday 16th June to Wednesday 28th July Sheffield is turning into a giant game! All over the city you may have noticed beat boxes appearing. These are for you to travel between on foot, scooter or by pedal power with the aim of visiting as many as you can.



On Monday 14th June each child will receive a fob, card, map and information pack to take part in Beat the Street Sheffield. The aim is for children (and adults) to get active by using their fob or card to tag each beat box. The more you tag in each journey the more points you will get for your school. The more points a school gets the higher up the leader board they will go in their local area, with the highest ranking schools winning prizes. The children will have an assembly on Monday 14th June to give them more details about the event.

The map your child will be given shows the location of each of the hundreds of beat boxes around the city. There is one located near each school in the city and many more within walking distance from each of these. Before you start playing you will need to register your card and/or fob on the website <https://www.beatthestreet.me/sheffield/> where you will also find lots of extra information including how to play and how your school is faring in the local leader board.

Each week of the competition has a specific theme, where extra points and prizes may be on offer! The first week is called 'Go Week', encouraging as many people to get out and active to start finding the beat boxes. There is a resource pack for each week and theme which we will share with you prior to each Wednesday via the newsletter and Class Dojo.

We hope you and your children enjoy taking part in Beat the Streets and we would love to hear how you get on. Please Dojo us pictures of you reaching each beat box and share with us at school how you are getting on. You may even see a few teachers out and about finding the boxes!
