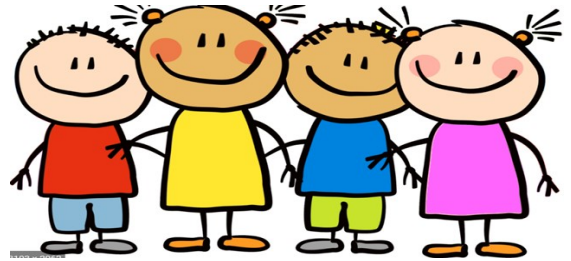

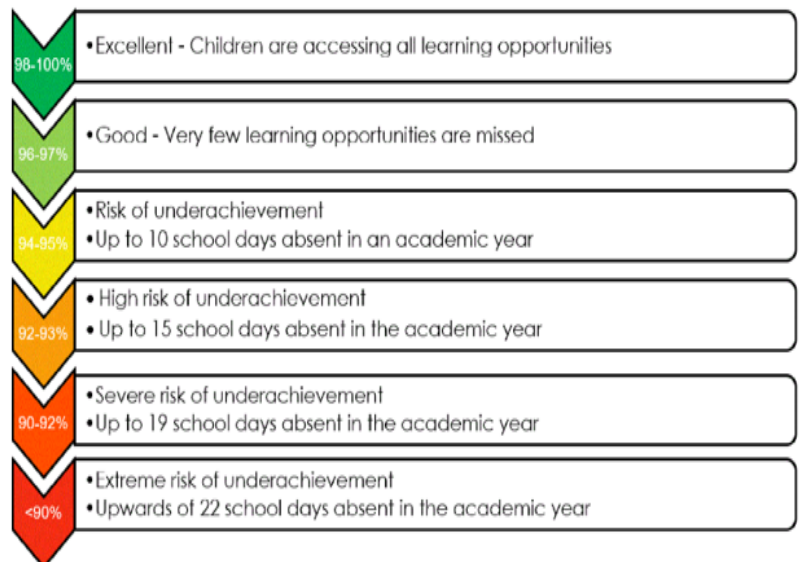

Punctuality
