In the meantime, we hope you all have a restful and enjoyable half term break. The children have earned it!

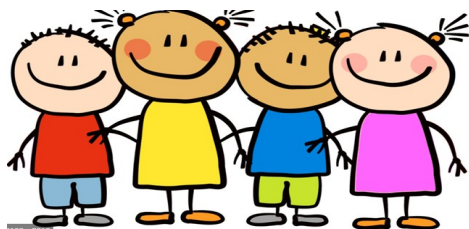

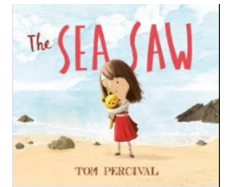

Author - Mini Grey

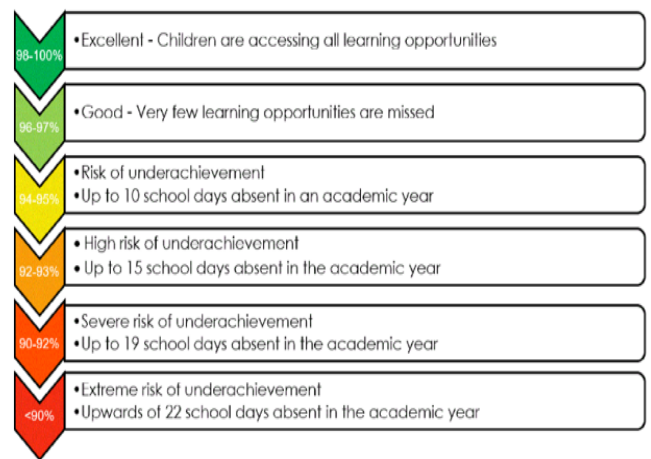
